

# TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAXES



## COLLECTIONS BY COUNTY CALENDAR YEARS 2018-2019

Counties may levy a tourist development tax or "bed tax" as a percent of the total charge (county rates vary) for the lease or rental of living accommodations in any hotel, apartment hotel, motel, resort motel, apartment, apartment motel, roominghouse, recreational vehicle park, mobile home park, or condominium for a term of six months or less. As of April 2020, 63 counties (out of 67 counties) in Florida have instituted a bed tax.
